Domestic Competition

Junior Representative Player Points Rule

1. Overview

All junior domestic teams with representative level players are required to comply with points restrictions based on the division each player competes. This rule applies to all players irrespective of their representative association. There is no restriction on the number of representative players per team provided they comply with the stipulated points limit.

2. Points Allocation

Points are allocated based on the division that players participate in the most recent Victorian Junior Basketball League (VJBL) competition in which grading has been completed:

- Winter domestic season – Players are allocated points based on the VJBL division they participate in the current VJBL season
- Summer domestic season – Players are allocated points based on the VJBL division they participated in previous VJBL season which concluded in September of that year

All players that play at least one round of the applicable VJBL championship season competition carry points through until the end of that domestic season.

3. Player Points

Player points are allocated as follows:

- **VJBL U12 Players:**
 - Victorian Junior Championship (VC) = 4 points
 - Victorian Junior League 1 (VJL 1) = 3 points
 - Victorian Junior League 2 (VJL 2) = 1 point
 - Victorian Junior League 3+ (VJL 3+) = 0 points
- **VJBL U14, U16, U18 and U21 Players:**
 - Victorian Junior Championship (VC) = 4 points
 - Victorian Junior League 1 or 2 (VJL 1&2) = 3 points
 - Victorian Junior League 3 or 4 (VJL 3&4) = 1 point
 - Victorian Junior League 5+ (VJL 5+) = 0 points
- **Big V/NBL1 Players:**
 - All divisions = 4 points

4. Points Limit

Teams may not exceed a total of 14 points.

5. Half Points Clause

Players that elect to participate in an age group older than their eligible age group will have half points applied.

6. Transferring Players

Players transferring from another state or country representative league may be allocated points at the discretion of the FDBA match committee.

7. Nomination Forms

Clubs must submit nomination forms for all teams with representative players within 5 days of submitting team registration. Any modification to team lists after registration requires approval from FDBA.
